So, let us get started without further ado.

Inductive Reasoning

Let's start off with the easier approach, ok?

What is inductive reasoning?

Inductive reasoning aims at one thing and that is to develop a theory. It can be any theory. But the point is that you have to develop it in your **custom essay**. How will you do that in such an essay? Let me give you an example.

How does inductive reasoning help in essays?

Here is your example.

Think of the thesis that you write for argumentative essays. It has a claim and then it has three supporting points.

Claim: Human beings cause global warming.

Support #1: Human beings cause pollution.

Support #2: Human beings cause deforestation.

Support #3: Human beings burn fossil fuels.

So, if we use inductive reasoning, we can say that since all these human activities cause global warming, then humans cause global warming.

See, what I did there?

Here, I used logic to prove my point.

I used a claim that I had and built its support to create the theory that humans are causing global warming.

Of course, this is a very simple example and your thesis can get complex but it will use the same logic and the same pattern.

Just remember this...

You will have to CREATE a theory in inductive reasoning. This is why it is most common in a thesis because we create a thesis ourselves or to reduce efforts you can hire a writer from [essay writer free](#).

Deductive reasoning

This is a bit more difficult but I will give an easy example for it, ok?

What is deductive reasoning?

Here, we already have a theory. When [online essay writer write my essay](#), they use deductive reasoning to prove the theory that I have. Again, in most cases, this "theory" is my thesis.

How is deductive reasoning helpful in essays?

Well, here is how you do it.

My theory is that humans cause global warming, right? Well, keep that in mind. Now, think about how I will prove my theory?

With the supporting arguments of course. But I will need to prove those arguments, right? So, we simply need to prove proof so that your theory can be proved.

In essays, you can provide proof in many ways.

How do I provide proof?

You can do that by citing studies. Anything that you find in a journal article is valid. Anything you find in an academic paper is also valid.

You can also use websites.

So, go to news websites like CCN. Or you can go to the website of the United Nations or Human Rights Watch. Reputable organizations only.

Any website of a government is also reputable.

What do I do with these sources?

Well, you use the information in these sources to prove your point.

You can say that a study finds that deforestation escalates global warming. That is PROOF.

Get it?

If you don't then do not panic.

It is all a little bit hard to grasp at first but will start making sense. In case of any confusion, you should get in touch with a writing website.

Just tell them which essay you want and mention the topic.

They use inductive and deductive reasoning in their essays so you can see how it is done, right?
